SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read the instruction manual carefully before first use and keep it for future reference. Producer is not responsible for damages caused by inappropriate handling and use of the device.



The lightning flash with arrowhead symbol, whith in an equilateral triangle is indicated to alert the user the presence of uninsulated, dangerous voltage, within the product enclosure that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute risk of electric shock to persons.

- Before connecting the device to power supply socket, make sure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to the voltage in the power supply socket.
- 2) Make sure to place this device on flat, dry and stable surface.
- Protect this device from moisture, humidity, water and any other liquid. Avoid using storing it in extreme temperatures. Do not expose it to direct sunlight and sources of heat.
- Product suitable for indoor use only.
- Disconnect the device from the power supply if it is not going to be used for a long time.
- 6) Protect power cord from harp edges and other factors which could lead to its damage.

PROGRAMMING TV BUTTONS ON RCU

The remote control of the receiver can also be programmed to perform the basic functions of the TV remote control.

This way, you can avoid using two remote controls when operating this receiver.

Programmable buttons: "TV CONTROL": POWER, SET, TV / AV, VOL-, VOL +.

- > Position the remote controls at a distance of 1-2 cm
- > Hold down the SET key until the white POWER button lights red.
- > While holding the WHITE POWER button press and hold the POWER button on the TV remote control until the white POWER button flashes three times.

When that button lights up red again, the programming of that button is over.

- > Repeat the above procedure for other key combinations: TV / AV> TV / AV or SOURCE / VOL-> VOL- / VOL +> VOL +
- > Press the SET key again to end the procedure the white POWER button will be extinguished.

1. STB

You should installation the receiver when powering on your product for the first time after purchase.

Note: The default password is 0000.

Main menu: Press the MENU button to enter the main menu.



2. Channel List

1.TV Channel List

TV Channels enables you to FAV, lock, Skip, Move and Edit the channels in the channel list conveniently.

2. Radio Channels List

Radio Channels operation similar to the TV Channels.

3.Parental Lock

Parental Control allows you to set limits for each program or change your previous password.

You can also lock the changes you have made using age limit, menu Lock and Channel manager Lock, also Change PIN Code.

4. Play Mode

Play model allows you to set the mode AV Sync or Stable.

3. Channel Search

1.Terrestrial

A)Auto Search



Search automatically and save the found channels.

In this menu you can choose different Country .

2.Cable Menu

A) Auto Search

Search automatically and save the found channels.

B) Manual Search

In this menu you can choose different Frequency to search for programs.

3. LCN

You can turn LCN on/off (Logical Sorting): If you set ON, the programs you search will be sorted in the order they were set; if you select off, the programs will be sorted automatically.

4. Sort

You can turn sorting by: ONID/Service ID/LCN.

4.Language



- Language: Set the menu language.
- First Audio: Set the preferred audio language.
- Second Audio: Set the second audio language.
- 4. Subtitle Language: Set the subtitle language.
- Teletext: Set the teletext language.
- EPG: Set the EPG language.

5. AV setting



- 1. TV System: In this menu, you can make settings auto, PAL and NTSC.
- Video Resolution: Set the HD format between 1080p. 1080i. 720p. 576i or 576p.
- 3. Aspect Mode: Set the display format according to the screen ratio. Select TV screen mode either 4:3 or 16:9 according to the TV type.
- 4. Video effects: Here you can set Standard, Vivid and Defult.
- 5. Scart Out: Here you can set CVBS
- 6. Audio Out: Here you can set BS Out and LPCM Out.
- Audio Description: set AD Service on or off.
- 8. Audio Description Volume

6.Time

Time Settings will set the time mode, time offset and summer time.



7. System

- 1.Information: you can get the information about the STB.
- 2.Factory Setting: will load default...
- 3.Timer Setting: add event timer
- 4.OSD Setting: Can set the subtitle display, OSD timout and OSD transparency.
- 5.USB Upgrade: Here you can upgrade the software.
- 6.USB Backup: Here you can backup the software.



8. Media Center

1. Music

It supports *.mp3, *.mp2, *.aac, *.format music files.
It can automatically download lyrics if the network is connected.

2. Picture

It supports *.jpg, *.png, *.mp4, *.bmp, *.jpeg, *.gif, *format pictures files.

3. Video

It supports *.mkv, *.avi, *.mp4, *.vob, *.ts, *.mt2s, *.flv, *.mpg, *.3gp, *mov format movie files.It will into full screen mode after a few seconds when there is on operation.

- 4. Record Manager: replay the PVR files.
- 5. DVR Configuration: set the tim shift and DVR Partition.



9. Network

1. WiFi

- A. Plug in the wireless USB dongle to the USB port.
- B. If the Network is connected, it should get the correct IP address and display the "Connect" and the AP name.

2. Ethernet

C. Connect one end of the Ethernet cable to the product and the other end to the LAN router, if the Network is connected, it should get the correct IP address and display "Status: Link Up".

- 3. 3G: You can get to 3G net when you plug the 3G net card.
- 4. Weather Forecas: You can get to weather information.
- 5. Yahoo News: Information service.
- Test Only- Net Link: Applications will be placed here only for testing purposes (the manufacturer does not quarantee their correct operation).

10. Trouble Shooting

No message displayed on the front display:

- a. Check the main power cable and make sure it is plugged into a suitable power outlet.
- b. Check that the mains supply is switched on.

No picture

 Make sure that the product is powered on and in operation mode, the AV/HDMI cable is firmly connected to the TV, and the antenna cable is properly connected to the product.

Poor picture/sound quality

- Make sure there is no mobile phone or microwave oven near the product.
- b. Check the signal levels and adjust the antenna direction to get a better picture

No or poor sound

 a. Check that your AV/HDMI cable is connected correctly or TV is on mute.

Remote control does not operate

 a. The top end of the remote control should point directly towards the receiving part of the product or replace new batteries
